## **How To Make An Eagle Scout Binder**

One way to present your Eagle Scout Rank Application is to assemble all of the information into a 3-ring binder with 8-dividers. Group your application information into six sections, with one divider tab for each requirement on the Eagle application. Use the last two tabs for any scouting, school, or community awards you would like to show to your Eagle Board members.

On top of the first divider put your verified/confirmed BSA Eagle Rank Application, an Advancement Report, along

with your current <i>Council Personal History Record</i> . Then behind each tab goes:
